Features of AS2 Stereo Bluetooth headset

- Transmit stereo music via Bluetooth Dongle. (IPOD, PSP, Mp3, HI-FI and other Audio Devices)
- Support A2DP mobile phone. The mobile phone can transmitted stereo music directly, No need the Bluetooth Dongle. (Mobile phone like Nokia N91, Motorola E680i)
- Pairing with Bluetooth Mobilephone, you can enjoy the music but never missing any call.
- Wirelessly Chat on Line. (Skype/MSN/QQ)
- Compatible with all functions of mono Bluetooth headset.
- Connect with computer USB port to charge.
- Using for a long time.
- Noise cancellation technology.

Battery Charging

The headset covers a built-in recharged battery. We recommend that you charge the battery until the headset indicator LED turns off before using the headset for the first time. During charging, the headset is turned off automatically and the indicator light shows a steady red light. When the battery is fully charged, the indicator LED switches off. It takes 2.5 to 3 hours to fully recharge battery.

Note: If the indicator LED flashes red at headset working or stand-by status, it means the headset needs to be recharged.

Headset on/Headset off

Headset on

Press and hold the multifunction button until you hear one short high tone. The indicator LED on the headset flashing blue.

Note: The first time the headset is turned on; it might automatically be ready for pairing.

Headset off

Press and hold the multifunction button until you hear one short high tone. The indicator light on the headset switches off after flashing red five times.

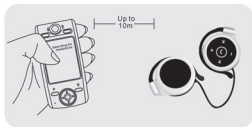


Pairing the headset with mobile phone

Turn on the headset and Pairing with mobile phone

- With the headset turned off, please press and hold the multifunction button for up to 8 seconds until the indicator LED on the headset flashes blue and red.
- Start Bluetooth functions according to the instructions in the phone's user manual.
- In a list device types that you can pair with your phone appears. Scroll to AS2. Make sure the headset is within 10m of the phone.

AS2 appears in the display, press YES. Enter the headset PIN code (0000), press YES. The phone pairing procedure starts. You may now replace the given headset name with a personal nametag, YES. When pairing has been completed, the indicator light will flash blue.



Pairing the headset with mobile phone



Note:

Pairing the Headset and the phone, these two devices will recognize each other. You don't need to pair them again unless you use the headset with other devices.

Pairing the headset with mobile phone

Enjoy the wonderful music wirelessly

After pairing the headset and the mobile phone, you can enjoy the sound from the documents of Audio and Video via the Bluetooth headset. You can enjoy music without wire limit. You can adjust the volume, play and stop the music, select the former song and next song by press the shortcut keys on the headset. The AS2 will stop the music to answer the phone automatically. After ending the call, the headset will play the music automatically.

Answer a phone call

When the mobile phone rings, please press multi-function key to talk.

Note: If the mobile phone rings before the headset please wait until headset rings and then press multifunction key.

End a phone call

Press multifunction key to end the call.

Reject a call

When a call incoming, please press the multifunction button 1 sec, the incoming call will end. (some mobile phones can not use this function because different mobile phone mode.)

Pairing the headset with mobile phone

Voice Dialing

- Make sure the headset and phone open and in respective effective range.
- Press the function key one time, then you can hear the indication of voice dialing and you can dial number at your will.
- Press multifunction key to end the call
Note: Check your mobile phone if support this item before using. More details please refer to User's Manual of mobile phone.

Redial the phone

- Make sure the headset and phone open and in respective effective range.
- Double press multifunction key, mobile phone will automatically redial last number you dialed.

Divert a phone call

- Make sure headset is on, and paired with the phone in effective range, even if you make a call, you also can transfer the sound to headset.
- During a call, press menu to transfer the sound to the headset, to complete the transaction between mobile phone and headset.
- If the connection to the headset is lost during an ongoing call, press YES key to transfer the call to the phone, otherwise the call is disconnected after 30 seconds.

Adjust Volume

- Adjust the headset speaker volume during a call:
Increase the volume, press "volume+"
Decrease the volume, press "volume-"

Note: In this menu, short press is only one second while long press is 3 seconds if no special instruction.

Headset LED indication

| Function | LED Display |
|--------------------|------------------------------|
| Power on | Blue light flashes 5s |
| Power off | Red light flashes 5s |
| Play music | Blue light flashes every 2s |
| Pair mode | Blue and red flashes in turn |
| Connect mode | Blue light flashes every 2s |
| Disconnection mode | Blue light flashes every 4s |
| Incoming | Blue light flashes every 2s |
| Recharge mode | Red light shows |
| Full charge | Red light off |
| Low battery | Red light flashe |
